

Calais, dále cesta nevede...

Reportáž je z města Calais ze severní Francie, kam byla několik let soustředěna pozornost světových médií. A to kvůli táboru, v němž přežívalo v posledních měsících na deset tisíc uprchlíků. Autor přibližuje jejich život včetně podmínek v táboře, zajímá se o jejich sny, tužby i plány a popisuje jejich snahu dostat se za každou cenu do Velké Británie.

SYNOPSIS (in English)

Jan Šmíd's report takes us to Calais, a city in the north of France which was the focus of the global media for several years due to a camp, in which around ten thousand refugees lived during the last months of its existence. The author describes the refugees' lives and the conditions in the camp; inquires about their dreams, desires, plans and struggles to get to the UK at all costs. To put things in broader context, the report also describes the feelings of the residents whose lives were affected by the proximity of the camp. Their anger is, however, not always directed at the refugees; often, it is directed at the government which allowed such a large group of people to live without human dignity. The camp was cleared up at the end of last year and the refugees were transported to around 150 places all over France.
